ABOUT OUR PROJECT

DEAR NEIGHBOR:

The Friends of Adair Park group is pleased to share with you this prospectus, an overview of our plans to renovate the playground structures within Adair Park I. The playground in Adair Park I has long been a popular destination in the community, drawing children and families from not only Adair Park but the surrounding area as neighbors visit or pass through the neighborhood. Today, that popularity has grown even more, as families from around the city visit Adair Park to venture out onto the Westside BeltLine – the terminus of which is a block from Adair Park I.

Friends of Adair Park is seeking \$115,000 in funding to replace the dated and broken playground equipment at this popular neighborhood gathering spot. We're thrilled to share that Friends of Adair Park recently secured an \$80,000 grant towards the project from the Park Pride Legacy Grant Program along with additional donations, leaving just \$24,000 to make this playground dream a reality. With only 25% left to meet our goal, our neighborhood is asking for your consideration in supporting this exciting project.

Park Pride and members of the Adair Park community recognize that great parks increase the quality of life of residents by supporting healthy people, strong neighborhoods, vibrant business districts, a robust economy and a healthy environment. The playground equipment improvement project, which includes a swing set and two new play structures, will enhance the quality of life for not just the youngest members of the Adair Park community, but all community members as this important greenspace is elevated and enhanced.


CURRENT STATE OF THE PARK

Adair Park I features a playground, gazebo, a large field for recreating, a 1-mile walking path loop, and a pavilion. It is a popular destination for recreating families and children, small parties and barbecues. The park is also the home to Adair Park's annual festival, Porches and Pies, which brings in hundreds of Georgians into the park each fall. Although the park's infrastructure was updated in 2008, the playground has seen minimal updates over at least the last four decades. Swing sets have chipping paint and damaged swings. Several play structures are broken. Root systems from nearby trees are trip hazards for kids and adults alike. While the playground is still well used, the equipment does little to enhance or inspire imaginative, active play.



Playground Creations was selected by neighbors as the favorite design, which includes a new swingset and two separate play structures. The final design will also include updated seating around the park and root mitigation.



POTENTIAL IMPACT OF THE PROJECT

Adair Park I serves as a community hub for gatherings, recreation and exercise. The playground is utilized daily, often all day long, by playing children, families, and even non-profit organizations hosting community recreational activities. Adair Park I is located within Adair Park neighborhood, which is in southwest Atlanta. We are a historically Black neighborhood and are located within a City of Atlanta Community Development Impact Area, which means at least 51 percent of the population are at or below 80% of the Atlanta area median income. As a result, our neighborhood works actively to implement projects that improve the quality of life for all residents of our community. Examples include our Senior Assistance program and Housing Justice Fund. We have also successfully managed multiple grant-funded park projects including the renovation of Bonnie Brae Park (2018-2019), creation of the Murph Community Garden in Adair Park II (2020), and the creation of the largest park-based mural in Atlanta by artist George F. Baker III in Adair Park II (2021).

What the Research Tells Us:

"Current evidence suggests that children have much to gain from time spent outdoors and much to lose from a lack of park access. In addition to myriad health benefits offered by physical activity in general, research has shown that outdoor exercise in nature can enhance emotional well-being and amplify the benefits of physical exercise. And for kids in particular, being in or near green spaces has been found to be associated with better test scores, improved self-discipline and cognition, and reduced behavioral problems and symptoms of attentiondeficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Several studies suggest that spending time outdoors can protect against myopia (nearsightedness). Still other research indicates that neighborhood green space may help mitigate income-related health disparities. Parks and green spaces also may contribute to population health by reducing exposures to air pollution and noise, capturing and filtering stormwater runoff, and mitigating heat-related illnesses. These benefits make urban parks an important tool in climate change adaptation." - Seltenrich, 2015
